- Pushing for family and community oriented businesses** on the St. Claude corridor and against more "convenience stores"
- Supporting more affordable housing and ownership** in the area
- Helping to establish and actively support a Neighborhood Watch program** and coordinating directly with the NOPD 5th district to protect our neighborhood
- HOSTING Candidate Forums** for city and state wide elections. We support The Lower Nine Voters' Coalition in getting voters informed and out on election days.

HCNA holds events such as the Night Out Against Crime, an annual Christmas gathering, and a 4th of July pot luck party. We would love to have your input and support again. Please attend one of the meetings or see contact information below.
